
The local audience is also familiar to sports associated to the forest and the smell of sawdust: The World Logging Championship was held just outside of Lillehammer in 1987!


Welcome to Håkons Hall – to a professional venue, tried and tested by Olympic games.

Scandic Lillehammer Hotel opened its doors in 1911, and is the regions biggest meeting point for conferences, vacations and weekend adventures.


The hotel is located in a large private park near the city centre of Lillehammer.

1st of July - Registration of time of arrival



Cancellation policy and refund


When you register as a participant for this event, by submitting your registration form to the ialc, you agree upon these terms and conditions regarding the event. By registration you agree to pay the full amount of the fan package, according to instructions given by the ialc. Cancellation must be made, by written notice to the ialc, before 15th of May 2018 in order to be eligible for a full refund.

For cancellation of fan package after May 15th the fan must pay 60 % of the fan package price.

For cancellation of fan package after June 15th the fan must pay 100 % of the fan package price.

WOMEN'S CLASS

We welcome women to step up to the international logging scene, with a brand new women's class at WLC2018!

With this new class, all countries will have the opportunity to participate with one more competitor at this years championship!

The women's class will be an integrated part of the competition and program, and the participants will get the same accommodation etc. as the other competitors (they will be treated the same as i.e. the junior class). The participants in the women's class will be ranked separately, and are not eligible for an official world champion title.

Women are of course able to compete as a part of their national team in the regular elite and junior class, like they have been able to at previous championships. In that case the ranking is not separate, and they can compete for the world champion title.

With a brand new women's class at the World Logging Championship 2018, we aim to empower more women to take their place and be a part of the international logging community!
